Entry Limitations and Regulations

Combined entries for all classes are limited to 8 hours per judge each day. Regular, optional titling & preferred class entries have priority, and will be accepted up to the limits for the assigned judge. Non-regular class entries will be conditionally accepted; after closing and making non-regular class judging assignments, these entries will be accepted in the order received, up to the limits for the assigned judge. Transfers will be accepted at the trial per AKC regulations. Running order exceptions may be made for handlers with multiple entries.

NO REFUNDS FOR ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITOR

The American Kennel Club (AKC) Rules and Regulations will govern this Trial and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the AKC referred to on the reverse side of the entry form in this Premium List

No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. **Signature required, unsigned entries, and entries received without payment will not be accepted. Note: Entry Forms without the full AKC Agreement and Rules and signature on the reverse side will not be accepted.**

GCOC assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry form by the owner or the owner's agent. ENTRANTS ALONE ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COMPLETENESS AND ACCURACY OF ALL INFORMATION ON THEIR ENTRY FORMS.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The Greater Columbia Obedience Club will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.

Refunds (minus an administration fee of \$5.00 per class) for bitches in season will be mailed to the Exhibitor after the conclusion of the trial if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made.

Entries will be acknowledged via email as they are received and processed. PLEASE VERIFY THE ACCURACY OF YOUR ENTRY INFORMATION as soon as you receive the processing email.

Confirmation and armband number will be sent via email after entries close. Those without an email address will be mailed by USPS to the address on the entry form. Please be sure to add **ShowEntries.Info** to your email allowed list.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Exhibitors alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.

LOSS OR DAMAGE - Both the Trial Committee and the Tri-City Leisure Center will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Trials. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is solely the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.

AWARDS will be awarded at the trial the day of the trial. No awards will be mailed.

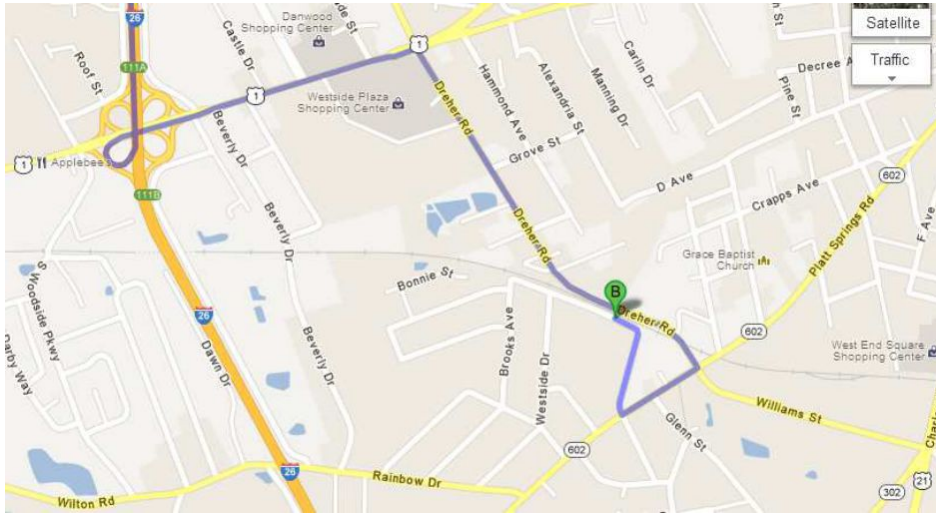

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL LOCATION

From Spartanburg/Greenville via I-385S to I-26 E and

From Charlotte via I-20 W, or via I-77S to I-20 W to I-26 E:

From I-26E, take Exit 111B to merge onto US 1 N / Augusta Rd toward West Columbia. Turn right onto Dreher Road. Turn right onto SC-602 / Platt Springs Road. Turn Right onto Brooks Avenue. Tri-City Leisure Center will be on the left.



From Augusta via I-20E: From I-20 E, take exit 58 for US-1 N toward Columbia Airport / West Columbia, then turn right onto US-1 N / Augusta Rd. Pass I-26, then turn right onto Dreher Road. Turn right onto SC-602 / Platt Springs Road. Turn Right onto Brooks Avenue. Tri-City Leisure Center will be on the left.
