Classes both days will run as follows:

AM trial: Master – Excellent – Advanced – Intermediate – Novice

PM trial: Novice – Intermediate – Advanced – Excellent – Master

All classes will run in descending jump height order beginning with the highest jump.

Exhibitors should leave the building when finished for the day. Also, you can use the time between classes to go get lunch or rest and return.

NO FOOD AVAILABLE AT THE TRIAL. Drinks will be available for purchase. Please plan to bring your own food. There are fast food restaurants nearby. A list of directions will be available for fast food selections within a short distance of the show site.

The state has set occupancy requirements. Please limit the amount of time spent in the building with your dog.

MASKS: Masks are required in the building, during walk throughs and while exhibiting. Maintaining social distancing is a must.

Judges will wear masks, so practice with masks.

Dogs are not allowed in the building once your exhibiting is complete for the day.

An inherent risk of exposure to communicable diseases exists in any public place. Communicable diseases can be extremely contagious and /or lead to severe illness and death.

Event attendees voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19 and any communicable disease related to humans and canines.

This event is closed to the public.

Exhibitors and club volunteers only. Please be mindful of social distancing, use of hand sanitizer regularly, and hand washing. Hand sanitizing stations will be located throughout the event area. Periodic sanitizing measures will be conducted several times during the day. A restroom facility is available on site.

Equipment: Chairs and crates are allowed. Approximately 30 6 ft x 6 ft taped spaces will be available. **A rug or mat is required under your equipment to protect the padded floor.**

No electric/battery fans will be allowed in the building.

Directions to the Show Site

From Greenville / Atlanta on I-85 North:

- Take Exit 66, US-29, toward Wellford / Spartanburg West, keep left on the ramp
- At the end of the ramp turn left toward Wellford / Lyman
- Turn left onto Greenville Hwy / US-29S
- Turn right onto Syphrit Rd
- Turn left onto Carver St, just past Astor St
- If you reach Brook St you have gone about .3 miles too far

From Charlotte

- Take I-85 South toward Greenville / Spartanburg
- Take Exit 66, US-29, toward Lyman/Wellford
- At the end of the ramp turn right
- Turn right onto Syphrit Rd
- Turn left onto Carver St, just past Astor St
- If you reach Brook St you have gone about .3 miles too far

From Columbia, SC

- Take I-26 West toward Spartanburg
- Merge onto US-29 South via Exit 21A toward Greer
- Turn right onto Syphrit Rd
- Turn left onto Carver St, just past Astor St
- If you reach Brook St you have gone about .3 miles too far

From Asheville, NC

- Take I-26 toward I-40
- Take Exit 10 SC-292 toward Inman
- Turn right onto Highway 292/SC-292 and continue to follow SC-292
- Turn left onto Bobo Rd. Bobo Rd becomes Carver St

No motor home parking allowed; no overnight parking allowed.

No dogs can be left in the building overnight.

Trial Entry Information and Trial Regulations

Entries are acknowledged via email as soon as they are received and processed. Please review and respond right away if any changes are noted. Armband numbers are confirmed and judging programs are distributed via email for all entries. This will be shortly after closing, when final judging assignments are complete, and exhibitor armband numbers have been assigned. Premium lists for future trials will also be sent out via email.

Refunds less administrative fee will be given for entries withdrawn in writing or via email before the closing date and time. DOCG will give refunds less administrative fee per AKC regulations for bitches that come into season after the closing date of the trial, and for no other reason. You must submit a signed statement of the dog's condition from your veterinarian on his/her office stationery along with your request for such a refund to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes before the start of the trial.

No refunds for errors on entry forms, or if a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused. No refunds if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club.

Changes or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or via email prior to the close of entries. Indicate **RAE (AB/EB), or RACH (AB/EB/Master)** if you want no entry if one class is already closed due to entry limitations.

Rally Jump Height is required for Advanced, Excellent and Master classes.

Entry Fees must be paid with entry submission for online entries. If a check is returned, we will add any bank fees to the amount due.

Transfers will be accepted per AKC regulations if you have earned a new title after closing, and if the class is not full. The fee difference will apply for transfers from a non-regular to a regular class. Completed and signed transfer form must be submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than **30 minutes** prior to the start of judging for the trial.

Show Site will be open for setup at 8:00 am Saturday morning. Show hours are 8:30 am - 5:30 pm Saturday & Sunday. No overnight parking Happy Dogs parking lot; no dogs may be left in the building overnight.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to crates, except when being judged or in designated warm-up areas. No Flexi leashes or prong collars permitted in the buildings. No ex-pens permitted in the buildings.

No camping permitted at the show site.

DOCG and Happy Dogs Training Center assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. For safety reasons, no strollers are permitted in the building during show hours.

Please clean up after your dog both inside and outside.

Please be respectful of the hotel and other guests – clean up after your dog.

Exhibitors must confirm with the hotel. Policies and circumstances at the motels could change at any time.
