Entry Limitations: Entries are limited to 8 hours of judging per judge each day. Entries will be accepted in the order received up until closing or until the 8 hour limit is reached. UDX, PUDX, RAE, and RACH entries will be accepted time permitting (fees for all classes apply).

Transfers will be accepted per AKC regulations. A completed, signed transfer form must be presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes before the start of judging for the trial. Transfers for trial 2 will be accepted until 15 minutes after the end of trial 1.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

COVID-19: Staying Safe & Having Fun!

Please read & follow these guidelines to make sure we have a safe & fun weekend:

1. **STAY HOME IF ...** you are sick, have a temperature, you do not feel well (fever, cough, sneezing, loss of taste/smell, problems breathing/catching your breath) or if you have been exposed to someone w/COVID-19 within 14 days prior to our shows. If you are at high risk, if you do not feel safe, if you do not feel comfortable, if you are scared, or if you feel we should not be having these shows.
2. If you want to have a good time, wear masks, AT ALL TIMES, practice social distancing, AT ALL TIMES, & show your dogs ~ COME & HAVE A GREAT WEEKEND AT OUR SHOWS!
3. Please be respectful to others, adhere to the rules & listen to all of our Committee Members, & above all ... HAVE FUN w/your dog!!!
4. **Masks must be worn AT ALL TIMES while on the Blacksburg Parks and Recreation grounds & in the building.** Bandanas will be permitted in addition to masks. Either must cover your nose, mouth, & chin to protect others. Judges will wear a mask in ring and on the grounds including in the building. Competitors must wear mask in the ring. If you wear a face shield, you must also wear a mask.
5. **NO Crating inside the building.**
6. Social Distancing must be adhered to whenever possible.
7. Shows are CLOSED to the general public. NO SPECTATORS !
8. No children under the age of 18 unless they are showing a dog.
9. Do not arrive earlier than one (1) hour before your judging time.
10. Our Committees reserve the right to wipe down & disinfect any common areas which are viewed to have been touched excessively.
11. NO FOOD will be served. There are several restaurants locally. You are welcome to bring your own drinks, snacks, &/or meals.
12. We are limited to the number of people in the gymnasium where the ring is located. Because of that limitation, competitors will only be allowed into the gym when showing and warming up. Warm up is done when one dog in ring and two dogs warming up. We will have two dogs warming up at a time.

There will be a volunteer at the entry to the gym monitoring who goes into the gym.
The gate board will be at this location.

13. Please pick-up after your dog.
14. NRVKC has the right to cancel this trial at any time. If the trial is cancelled, & you have already entered, your check will be shredded or you will be refunded.
15. If the State of Virginia, Gov. Northam, CDC, or the AKC make changes according to COVID-19, we will abide by the State, Governor, CDC, &/or AKC changes.
16. These COVID-19 Rules are in the premium therefore when you enter the trial you are agreeing to all things in the premium

Canadian Exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. Accounts or with International Money Orders in U.S. Funds.

There will be refunds for bitches in season, providing a letter or email from your veterinarian is received at least 30 minutes before the start of the trial on Saturday morning.

Dogs need to be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dogs holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be claimed the day of a show- none will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen, and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. The Show Secretary is not able to cash checks.

RETURNED CHECKS/INVALID CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check and credit/debit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit/debit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary.

The show giving Club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by email to the trial secretary prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.
