If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show an additional \$3.00 event service fee is due the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rule Chapter 14, Section 2).

BREED, SWEEPSTAKES AND OBEDIENCE EXHIBITORS - Please note the color of your dog on your entry form.

Closing Date: 12 NOON, Wednesday January 24, 2024, at the Show Secretary's Office Greer, SC after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, or substituted. Enter Online at https://ShowEntries.info/, or mail paper entries to Show Secretary, ShowEntries 120 Cliffwood Lane, Greer, SC 29650. Make Checks payable to the ShowEntries. Canadian Exhibitors make fees payable in U.S. Funds. Entries not accepted without fees. No entry shall be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by act of the Show Committee.

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Telegraph, Telephone, and Unsigned Entries cannot be accepted. Entries Received without fees will not be accepted.

SEMEN FREEZING CLINIC

Lacey Rosenberg, DVM, DACT and her teamfrom Veterinary Specialties at the Lake will be available on (Saturday and Sunday) from 9 AM until 3 PM for pre-reserved semen collections/cryopreservation (freezing).

Drop ins will also be available but reserving an appointment in advance can help streamline the process. If you are interested in services other than those listed, please contact the team at Veterinary Specialties for information on availability and pricing. Contact the team with any questions or to reserve your spot in advance by contacting them via email at info@vetspecslkn.com (please put "Labrador Specialty Freeze Clinic" in the Subject) OR via phone at 828-478-3500.

When calling, please reference the Labrador Specialty Semen Freezing Clinic and ask for Jenn or Star. Requirements include a current brucellosis test within 6 months, or a test can be run via a blood draw at the clinic for an additional fee (see below).

It is strongly recommended that your dog be microchipped and have DNA on file with the AKC. These services can be provided at the clinic. Pricing is as follows:

- Semen collection, complete evaluation, cryopreservation, and complimentary storage for 1 year: \$400
- Semen collection and full evaluation only without cryopreservation: \$125 Semen collection, evaluation, and chill testing in extender: \$200
- Semen collection "practice": \$55
- AKC DNA swabbing and submission: \$50
- Brucellosis testing (required within 6 months of freeze): \$50
- Microchip implantation: \$30

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
