Jump Height is required for all obedience and rally classes with jumps.

Classes with jumps will run in ascending jump height order, beginning with the lowest jump in all trials. Exceptions to jump height running order may be made for handlers with multiple entries.

**Trials will run consecutively** on Saturday and Sunday. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when its class is called.

Transfers will be allowed per AKC regulations. Transfer form must be submitted to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes before the start of judging each day.

Refund for bitches in season with veterinarian's certificate, submitted at least 30 minutes before the show. If you have any guestions or to request an inseason refund, contact the CDTC Trial Secretary -Heather Summers 4pawsandatail@comcast.net

All dogs present must be on leash or confined to a crate except when being judged in the ring.

Tents outside will be available for crating. Crating space will be available on a limited basis. There is no crating space for unentered dogs.

There is plenty of free parking close to the building and a large grassy area adjacent to the building.

Crates may be left overnight; however, the club will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site

Water will be available for competitors.

Event may be cancelled due to extreme weather conditions.

## **IMPORTANT COVID-19 RULES**

If you plan to enter CDTC shows, be advised we are governed by any COVID protocols in effect at the time of the shows. If those protocols change after the shows close those changes will not constitute a reason to withdraw your entry.

## **Directions to the trial site**

#### From Spartanburg/Greenville via I-385S to I-1-26E

Take Exit 209(Ashley Phosphate Road). Use the right 2 lanes to turn right onto Ashley Phosphate Rd/State Rd S-10-75. Go 0.7 miles. Turn right onto Southrail Road. Go 0.7 miles. Turn right into group of buildings. Training facility is the 2<sup>nd</sup> building on the right (300A).

#### From Charlotte via I-77S

Take I-77to I-26 E. Take Exit 209(Ashley Phosphate Road). Use the right 2 lanes to turn right onto Ashley Phosphate Rd/State Rd S-10-75. Go 0.7 miles. Turn right onto Southrail Road. Go 0.7 miles. Turn right into group of buildings. Training facility is the 2<sup>nd</sup> building on the right (300A).

#### From Augusta via I-20E

Stay on I-20E, merge onto I-26E at Exit 64A toward Charleston.

Take Exit 209(Ashley Phosphate Road). Use the right 2 lanes to turn right onto Ashley Phosphate Rd/State Rd S-10-75. Go 0.7 miles. Turn right onto Southrail Road. Go 0.7 miles. Turn right into group of buildings. Training facility is the 2<sup>nd</sup> building on the right (300A).

#### From Savannah

Take I-95 to US-17 North towards Charleston. Follow signs for I-526 East towards North Charleston. Use right lane to take exit 17 for I-26 W towards Columbia. Use right lane to take exit 209A/209B for Ashley Phosphate Rd. Take a left onto Ashley Phosphate Rd. Turn right onto Southrail Road, go 0.7 miles turn right into group of buildings. Training facility is the 2nd building on the right (300A.)
