# ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

## Please read before entering!

By entering this trial, you are verifying that your dog possesses a current Rabies vaccination on the day of the trial. Please have documentation of your dog's rabies vaccination available should a show official request it.

Precautions, restrictions, and other safety recommendations associated with human health and canine health will be posted to [rdoc.org](http://rdoc.org) and signage will be posted to the glass doors of the main and annex buildings. IF YOU are not well OR your DOG is not well, please do not attend these events.

### Directions to RDOC 2004 Tomlynn St. Henrico, VA 23230 :

From Interstate 64, take exit #185, Staples Mills Rd. Rt. 33 East. Merge onto Staples Mills Rd. At the first light, Bethlehem Rd, turn left. Bethlehem Rd. makes a slight right and becomes Dabney Rd. Take the first left onto Tomlynn St. The entrance for RDOC will be on the right just after Jacque St.

This is a non smoking building.

There is a bathroom in the Main Building and there is a small bathroom in the Annex. There will be 1 handicap accessible Port-a-John located in the parking lot.

Exhibitors may unload their cars to crate in the Annex, both Saturday and Sunday, beginning at 7 a.m. After unloading, cars should be moved across Tomlynn Street to the area marked EVENT PARKING.

The parking at RDOC has changed with new businesses having moved in. The six spots in front of the auto repair shop are now completely off limits to us, even after hours and on the weekend. **DO NOT PARK THERE!** They have threatened to have cars towed. There will be cones in those spots to mark them.

Do not park in the Fire Lane behind the building. Fire trucks must be able to drive between the dumpster and the building. The fire lane is marked on the pavement. Parking in the fire lane could result in your being towed.

Please **clean up after your dogs** – The dog potty area is the gravel lot across from the Annex. There are bags for you to clean up and a trash can for disposal.

Do not potty your dog in the mulched beds along Tomlynn Street. Do not allow your male dog to relieve himself on the walls or doors of the building.

Flexi-Leads are not permitted in the building.

Dogs that are not entered will not be allowed in the Main building.

No dog whistles are permitted.

A limited number of spectators will be allowed to be seated in the main building. Please be respectful to the exhibitors. Please do not bring your dog with you while you are watching the trial.

**ALL CLASSES** – dogs will be judged from low to high jump height for all classes.

Ring size is 40' x 50'.

Entry fees shall not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

Extreme weather conditions such as but not limited to snowstorms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat/cold must be considered for the safety of everyone involved. In the event the trial is canceled due to extreme weather or halted due to extreme weather no refund of entry fee will be made.

Dogs may arrive approximately one hour prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging are excused. All dogs must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

Exhibitors and spectators will enter through the lobby of the Main Building and will exit through the exit door at the far end of the building. There will be one-way traffic in the building. Do not attempt to enter the building through the exit door. Volunteers will assist you as you enter the lobby's warm-up area, which is matted, to the quiet area, to the quiet corner outside of the ring, into the judging area and out of the exit door.

Exhibitors may watch the large screen TV in the Annex and utilize the check-in board to ensure that they are ready to enter the warm-up area as their turn approaches. It is your responsibility to make sure that you will be on time for your run.

The Judge will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents are responsible for having their dogs present at the ring when their classes are called to be judged.

Rally Maps will be posted to [www.rdoc.org](http://www.rdoc.org) on Friday evening after 6:00 pm. Go to the website, select the Trials & Events tab. Click on the blue bar associated with the trial. On the day of the trial, Rally maps and Obedience Utility and Open "B" class patterns will be posted in the annex on the wall.
