Jump Height is required for all obedience and rally classes with jumps. Classes with jumps will run in **ascending** jump height order, beginning with the lowest jump. Exceptions to jump height running order may be made for handlers with multiple entries.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when its class is called.

Transfers will not be allowed after closing,

except in the case of ineligibility as per AKC rules and regulations.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.

All dogs present must be on leash or confined to a crate except when being judged in the ring.

Crating space will be available on a limited basis, first come. Catalogs will not be available for purchase.
