Exhibitors must remain for presentation or they forfeit such prizes.

Trial Entry Information and Trial Regulations

Unsigned entries and entries without payment are not accepted. No entry will be accepted which specifies conditions as to its acceptance.

Entries are acknowledged via email as soon as they are received and processed. Please review and respond right away if any changes are noted. No changes after closing.

Armband numbers are confirmed and judging programs are distributed via email for all entries. This will be shortly after closing when exhibitor armband numbers have been assigned. Premium lists for future trials will also be sent out via email.

No refunds for errors on entry forms, or if a dog is absent (except bitches in season), disqualified, or excused. No refunds if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club.

Entry fees for Bitches in season will be refunded (less a \$5 processing fee per entry) with the appropriate Veterinarian Certificate. To be eligible you must notify the Onsite Trial Secretary by email or letter 30 minutes prior to the start of judging the first class at the trial, together with a veterinarian's certificate confirming the fact that the bitch is in season.

Changes or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or via email prior to the close of entries.

Indicate **RAE (AB/EB)** or **RACH (AB/EB/Master)** if you want no entry if one class is already closed due to entry limitations.

Rally Jump Height is required for Advanced, Excellent and Master classes.

Entry Fees must be paid with entry submission for online entries. If a check is returned, the club will add any bank fees to the amount due.

Transfers will be accepted per AKC regulations if the class is not full. Completed and signed transfer form must be submitted to the Onsite Trial Secretary no later than **30 minutes** prior to the start of judging for the trial.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to crates, except when being judged or in designated warm-up areas. No Flexi leashes or prong collars permitted in the buildings. No ex-pens permitted in the buildings.

No smoking allowed anywhere indoors.

Please bring your lunch. No food will be available for sale. There are a number of fast food restaurants and eateries close to the show site.

There will be no official photographer available at this trial.

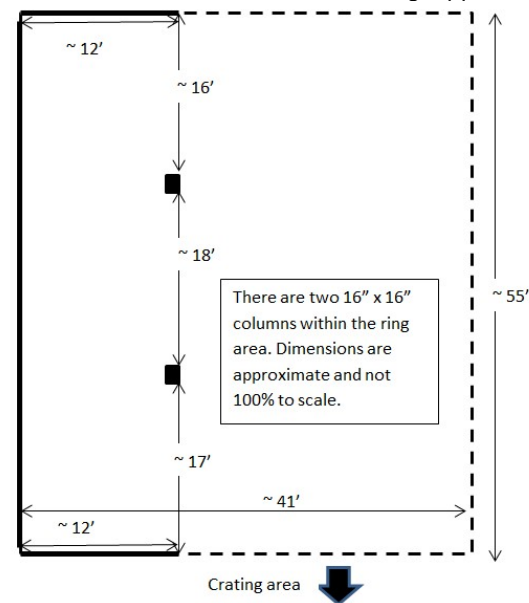

Directions to the Show Site

From the South - Take the Garden State Parkway North to Exit 168 (Washington Avenue). At top of ramp, make right onto Washington Ave. Make right hand turn onto Broadway just after crossing railroad tracks. Broadway turns into Old Hook Road and follow directions "From Old Hook Road" below.

From George Washington Bridge & East - Take Route 4 West to the Garden State Parkway North and follow From the South directions above.

From the West - Take Route 80 East to Garden State Parkway North and follow From the South directions above.

From the North - Take the New York State Thruway (287) to Exit 13 South. Route 304 South turns into Kinderkamack Road. Turn left onto Old Hook Road.

From Old Hook Road - Turn at the traffic light, Charles Street, in front of Hackensack University Medical Center at Pascack Valley. Make next left onto Bergenline Avenue. Our location is the last building on the right on the first block. Entrance to our building is facing Bergenline Avenue. When you enter the building, our facility is just inside the door to the right on the ground floor.
