Jump Height is required for all obedience classes with jumps.

Classes with jumps will run in **ascending jump height order**, beginning with the lowest jump in all trials. Exceptions to jump height running order may be made for handlers with multiple entries.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when its class is called.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in rally or obedience trials. The club will refund entry fees, less \$10.00 per entry, for bitches in season that are unable to compete for that reason. Refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete.

The Trial Secretary must be notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial.

There will be no refund for injury or illness after entries close.

Attention Veteran entrants: When the obedience trial entries open (8:00 am, Wed July 15th), MHDTC encourages early entry for Veteran Obedience! MHDTC presents customized rosettes for each Veteran Obedience entry with the dog's name and AKC titles and that takes extra time to prepare. Please be sure to clearly state the name and titles you want on the rosette as we will use the entry information for the rosette.

No food or beverages available onsite. Many fast food restaurants are available nearby.

There will be no indoor crating for exhibitors in the Top Dog building.

Exhibitor crating will be available in the Top Dog Day Care.

Tarps/sheets/towels must be placed under all crates, no exceptions.

Parking: All vehicles must be parked nose in - not parallel with edges of parking area.

From Rt 80 East or West (exit 27A) to Rt 206 South:

Go 4 miles, turn right onto Bartley Rd, just before the railroad overpass. Go about a mile to Top Dog on the right.

From Rt 287 (exit 22B) to Rt 206 North:

Take Rt.206 through the town of Chester and cross the intersection of Rt.206 and Rt.24/Rt.513. Stay on Rt.206 to the third traffic light and make a left onto Bartley-Chester Rd. Cross over railroad tracks. Top Dog entrance is immediately on the left (red building).
