**Changes** or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or via email prior to the close of entries. Entries are acknowledged via email as received. Entries are confirmed and the judging program is distributed via email when all entries are processed, final judging assignments are complete, and exhibitor armband numbers have been assigned.

Indicate '**UDX**' or '**RAE**' if you are entering both OB & UB or both AB & EB and you want no entry if one class or the other is already closed due to entry limitations (Obedience Regulations: Chapter 1 Section 27).

**Obedience High Jump Height is required for all entries** in classes with jumps. **Rally Jump Height** is required for Advanced and Excellent classes.
