Entry Limitations and Regulations – please read carefully

Combined entries for all classes are limited to 8 hours per judge each day. Regular and optional titling class entries have priority, and will be accepted up to the limits for the assigned judge. Non-regular class entries will be conditionally accepted; after closing and making non-regular class judging assignments, these entries will be accepted in the order received, up to the limits for the assigned judge. Rally is limited to 88 entries each day. Transfers will be accepted at the trial per AKC regulations. All classes will be run in **forward catalog order on Saturday** (ascending jump height, beginning with the lowest jump height entered for classes with jumps); and in **reverse catalog order on Sunday** (descending jump height beginning with the highest jump height entered for classes with jumps). Exceptions may be made in obedience for handlers with multiple entries.

DOCG is pleased to offer an OC Match with ring time for "run-thrus" in one of 4 rings setup for Pre-Novice, Novice, Open, and Utility runs.

Handlers may select class exercises to be performed within a 5 minute block of time. Entries are limited to 2-1/2 hours of match time.
Second runs may be available, time permitting.

There are no prizes, ribbons, scoring or placements for the Match.

Verbal corrections and gentle guidance will be permitted.

No food or toys will be permitted in the rings.

Group sits and downs are included at no additional charge for dogs signed up for the **Novice or Open** ring. Group exercises will be conducted at appropriate intervals at the club's discretion.

Match Ring Time entries for first runs will be accepted only in advance, and only for dogs that are entered in our trials on Saturday or Sunday. Match entries will be accepted in the order received up to match ring time limits. Second runs, if available, may be paid for at the match.

Sign In at your ring when you arrive for running order.

To enter, check off ring(s) (Pre-Novice, Novice, Open, Utility) on your entry form, and submit payment with your trial entry. You may enter online. Again, there is a 5 minute time limit for each first run.

Match Fee will be refunded if the match ring is full. Enter early - the match is very popular. DOCG club members will conduct the match and match workers will do their own ring time separately before the match begins.

Trial Entry Information and Trial Regulations

Entries are acknowledged via email as soon as they are received and processed. Please review and respond right away if any changes are noted. Armband numbers are confirmed and judging programs are distributed via email for all entries. This will be shortly after closing, when final judging assignments are complete, and exhibitor armband numbers have been assigned. Premium lists for future trials will also be sent out via email.

Refunds will be given for entries withdrawn in writing or via email before the closing date and time. DOCG will give full refunds per AKC regulations for bitches that come into season after the closing date of the trial, and for no other reason. You must submit a signed statement of the dog's condition from your veterinarian on his/her office stationery along with your request for such a refund to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes before the start of the trial.

No refunds for errors on entry forms, or if a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused. No refunds if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club.

Changes or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or via email prior to the close of entries. Indicate '**UDX**' or '**RAE**' if you are entering both OB & UB or both AB & EB and you want no entry if one class or the other is already closed due to entry limitations (Obedience Regulations: Chapter 1 Section 27).

Obedience High Jump Height is required for all entries in classes with jumps. **Rally Jump Height** is required for Advanced and Excellent classes.

Entry Fees must be paid right away via Paypal for online entries. If a check is returned, we will add any bank fees to the amount due.

Transfers will be accepted per AKC regulations if you have earned a new title after closing, and if the class is not full. The fee difference will apply for transfers from a non-regular to a regular class. Completed and signed transfer form must be submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than **30 minutes** prior to the start of judging for the trial.

Show Site will be open for setup from 5:00-8:30 pm Friday. Show hours are 7:00 am - 4:00 pm Saturday & Sunday. No overnight parking in the activity center parking lot except with Club permission; no dogs may be left in the building overnight.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to crates, except when being judged or in designated warm-up areas. No Flexi leashes or prong collars permitted in the buildings. No ex-pens permitted in the buildings.

No camping permitted at the show site.

DOCG assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. For safety reasons, no strollers are permitted in the building during show hours.
