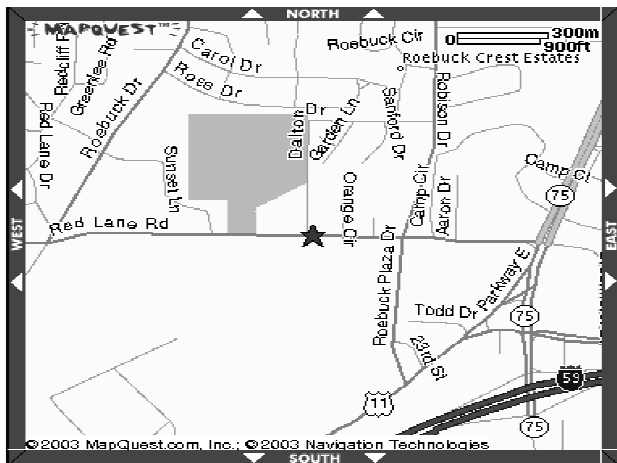
Route/Map to Show Site

From the North: Take I-65 toward Birmingham. Take Exit 261A - I-59 North - (left exit) toward Gadsden. Go approx. 9 miles to Exit 134. At light at end of ramp, turn left. Go through 3 lights to fourth light (Chick Fil-A & Mobil on right, Arby's & Exxon on left) and turn left there onto Red Lane Road. Go through light and take first drive on left into ball field. Training facility is on your left as you go in the drive.

From the South: Take I-65 North toward Birmingham. Take I-459 North exit toward Hwy280/Atlanta/Gadsden. Continue on I-459 until it ends and merges onto I-59. Take I-59 South toward Birmingham. Take Exit 134 and bear right on ramp. Go through 3 lights to fourth light (Chick Fil-A & Mobil on right, Arby's & Exxon on left) and turn left there onto Red Lane Road. Go through light and take first drive on left into ball field. Training facility is on your left as you go in the drive.

From the East: Take I-20 East toward Birmingham. Take the I-459 North exit toward Gadsden. Continue on I-459 until it ends and merges onto I-59. Take I-59 South toward Birmingham. Take Exit 134 and bear right on ramp. Go through 3 lights to fourth light (Chick Fil-A & Mobil on right, Arby's & Exxon on left) and turn left there onto Red Lane Road. ENTRIES close Wednesday, October 22, 2014 at 6:00 PM CDT, after which time entries cannot be accepted, altered, substituted, or cancelled. All entries must be online, or on an Official AKC Entry form, completed and signed, and must include the Agreement and Instructions on the reverse side. Entries will not be accepted without the proper form, signature(s), fees, or if the entry specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Incomplete, inaccurate, or illegible entries will not be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A \$35.00 fee will be charged for a returned check. Please type or print legibly.

Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate.

RUNNING ORDER and JUMP HEIGHT: All classes requiring jumps will be arranged in jump height order. All classes will be run in **forward catalog order on Saturday** (ascending jump height, beginning with the lowest jump height entered for classes with jumps); and in **reverse catalog order on Sunday** (descending jump height beginning with the highest jump height entered for classes with jumps). Exceptions may be made in obedience for handlers with multiple entries. Please refer to **AKC Obedience and Rally Regulations** for the description of classes, eligibility, and proper jump heights.

ERRORS ON ENTRIES: Owners are responsible for the accuracy of the information required on the entry form. **Changes, additions, or corrections to an entry, entry substitutions, or cancellations by the owner must be received in writing or via email by the Trial Secretary prior to closing.**

REFUNDS: Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date, due to errors, omissions, cancellations, or for duplicate entries. A refund of entry fees will not be given in the event a dog is absent, disqualified or excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee; or if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, or any emergency or other cause beyond the control of the Club. There will be refunds for bitches that come in season after the closing date, with a dated veterinarian's certificate. Bitches in season may not be at the show site at any time.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

TRANSFERS: Transfers will be accepted per AKC regulations if you have earned a new title after closing, and if the class is not full. Completed and signed transfer form must be submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of judging for the trial..

JUDGING: Exhibitors are responsible for being ready at the ring gate for judging. The Judging Program will be sent to exhibitors via email shortly after closing. Judging schedule conflicts should be resolved with the judge at the trial, prior to the start of the class. Judges are not required to wait for any exhibitor. Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

SHOW SITE: All dogs must be held on a leash or confined to a crate except when in the ring for judging. Dogs must be on a leash when being exercised, trained or when warming up. **No exercise pens or dog cots are allowed in the building.** Please maximize available crating space but do not crate within 10 feet of the ring gates. Dogs must be removed from the building immediately following the end of the Trial. **BOTC reserves the right to remove any dog in distress in a parked vehicle or crate.**

Please keep the grounds clean by picking up after yourself and your dog. An exercise area outside the facility will be plainly marked. Use this area only and dispose of 'poop' bags in the trash containers provided there. Please keep your crating area, the trial site, RV grounds, and motel rooms and grounds clean so we may continue to be welcomed at these facilities.

CONDUCT: It is expressly understood that all owners/agents/exhibitors are solely responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any person(s) whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such cases no refund of any fees/monies paid will be made.

All owners/agents/exhibitors and other persons attending these trials hereby waive any claim against the club or its agents, for any losses, damages, or injuries affecting self, dogs, children, or personal property.

WARM-UPS and training should be conducted in accordance with Chap 2, Sect 26 of the AKC Obedience Regulations.
